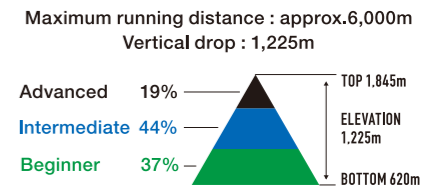
Follow the directional arrow signs on the trail guide

Requests for Kagura Ski Resort visitors who venture outside (backcountry) the Trail Supervising Area Boundary

- Leave the boundaries at the designated spots to avoid mishaps.
- Remove your skis when going outside the boundaries to avoid leaving ski-trails which may cause a mishap.
- We ask that you submit the specified mountain climbing notification every time without fail. (We will keep it for the police.)
- Please confirm that you have the gear necessary for backcountry before setting off outside controlled access areas. Furthermore, at the BC gate, there is a check to ensure you have the minimum necessary gear.
- Skiers will take responsibility for their activities when outside the boundaries.
- It is recommended that skiers carry a device for determining latitude/longitude in the event of an emergency.
- Skiers should bring a communication device at all time just in case of emergency.
- For the latest weather and snowfall information, please check the Kagura Ski Resort website and our social media.
- Emergency search and rescue charges will be fully paid at your own expense.
- In the event of an emergency, please inform your name, contact address and number, color of your ski gear, the location where you went outside the boundary, your present physical condition (mishap, injury, snow-slide) and your latitude/longitude. The police will be informed of the situation and we will act in accordance to their instructions. Thank you for your cooperation in helping prevent accidents.
